August Summer Themes at Pathway

Week 1 – Seashells and Ocean Life

The children will learn about seashells and ocean life during the first week of August. We will classify sea shells by size and shape. We will learn about dolphins and whales. We will also learn about the five zones of the ocean.

Week 2- Plants and Gardening

The children will learn about plants and gardening during the second week of August. We will dissect and label the parts of a sunflower. We will plant and care for pumpkin seeds. We will count pumpkin seeds from

1 to 20. We will also study the life cycle of a pumpkin. The children will paint sunflowers and a thumbprint painting pumpkin patch.

Week 3 – Bugs and Butterflies

The children will learn about bugs and butterflies during the 3rd week of August. We will study the life cycle of a butterfly. The children will also learn about helpful and harmful bugs. Then we will count the insects from 1 to 20.

Week 4- Pond Animals

During the last week of August, the children will learn about pond animals and reptiles. They will study the parts of a turtle. Then the children will count the frogs from 1 to 20. We will also learn about the life cycle of a frog.
